



River City Water Ski Show Team Membership Fees and Requirements for 2019 Season

*WWSF Dues Optional- only needed if you plan to participate at the State Tournament in July.

Membership Notes:

- The team requires **FULL PAYMENT** of River City Team Dues before a skier can participate in open water (river) practices or shows. If unable to pay in full, please contact the Treasurer (Lori Greiner).
- Anyone with a main role in the ski shows (skiers, drivers, spotters, dock help, announcer, sound, etc.) will need an active USA Water Ski membership. The USA Water Ski membership fee for *non-skiing* show personnel may be reimbursed at the end of the season at the discretion of the Board.
- 20-service hours per family are required.
- **A minor child (under 18) joining the team must have a parent join with them.**

Policies and Procedures:

- Read Member's Handbook and sign Acknowledgment Form.
- Attend practices regularly; inform Show Director of any absences prior to practice.
- No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking, or foul language allowed at the ski site before, during, or immediately following practice or a show.
- No member may participate in a show or practice while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- USA Water Ski membership must be current. Pay directly to www.usawaterski.org.
- WI Water Ski Federation membership must be current for State. Pay directly to www.waterski.org
- One member from each family must volunteer with at least one committee.
