Membership Notes:

- The team requires **FULL PAYMENT** of River City Team Dues before a skier can participate in open water (river) practices or shows. If unable to pay in full, please contact the Treasurer.
- Anyone participating in practices (skiers, drivers, spotters, etc.) will need an active USA Water Ski membership.
- **A minor child (under age 18) joining the team must have a parent/ guardian join as well.** The parent/guardian does not need to pay USA or WWSF fees unless he/she plans to ski or have a major part in the show. River City does not charge its non-skiing members.

Policies and Procedures:

- Complete 2020 RCWS Registration Form with appropriate signatures
- Complete 2020 COVID-19 Waiver Form with appropriate signatures.
- Read Members Handbook
- Be sure to accept the invitation to the Remind App- this is how immediate information is sent to the team (weather cancellations, etc.)
- Attend practices regularly by signing up for your ski slot as per instructions to follow.
- If you cannot attend the slot you signed up for, please provide 24 hour notice whenever possible, or, as soon as able. This allows us to open the slot to another skier. Notice can be given to any Board member or by texting the Remind App.
- No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking, or foul language allowed at the ski site before, during, or immediately following practice or a show.
- No member may participate in a show or practice while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- USA Water Ski membership must be current. Pay directly to www.usawaterski.org.
