Membership Notes:

- The team requires **FULL PAYMENT** of River City Team Dues AND USA Waterski dues before a skier can participate in open water (river) practices or shows. If unable to pay in full, please contact Brad Gates, brad@rivercitywaterski.com
- All members/families will need to prepay some of the fundraiser amounts for Fall and Spring
 Fundraisers that are occurring for that specific year. For the 2023 season we will be participating in a
 Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 Cookie fundraiser, RiverFest (June 30-July 4th), & Beer Cheese Wine Fest
 (April 2023).
- Any member 18 years and older that is a skier or a non-skier helping with the show in any means
 (skiers, drivers, spotters, dock help, announcer, sound, etc.) needs to have SAFE SPORT completed prior
 to first day of practice, including dryland). For questions on this requirement contact Luke Raymer,

- Anyone with a main role in the ski shows (skiers, drivers, spotters, dock help, announcer, sound, etc.) will need an active USA Water Ski membership.
- 20-hours of volunteer service for team per family are required
- A minor child (under age 18) joining the team must have a parent/guardian join as well. The parent/guardian does not need to pay USA or WWSF fees unless he/she plans to ski or have a major part in the show. River City does not charge its non-skiing members.

Policies and Procedures:

- Read and sign Member's Handbook Acknowledgement form
- Attend practices regularly; inform show director(s) of absence prior to practice.
- No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking/vaping/e-cigs, or foul language allowed at the ski site before, during, or immediately following practices/shows.
- No members may participate in a show or practice while under the influence of drugs/alcohol.
- USA Water Ski membership must be current. Pay directly to www.usawaterski.org
- WI Water Ski Federation membership must be current if participating in the State Tournament. Pay directly to www.waterski.org
- Volunteer with at least one committee
- Must participate in yearly fundraisers
