2024 Season**

**You will NOT be allowed to ski until ALL fees are paid.**

**Development Team Skiers (not skiing shows, Riverfest, or the State Tournament)** are only required to pay team dues, fundraising fee, and USA Waterski membership. No WWSF membership is necessary.

**Non-Skiing Show team members such as Drivers, Spotters, sound, ect need USA Waterski and WWSF memberships ONLY. There are no team dues for non-skiers.**

### Membership Notes:

- The team requires **FULL PAYMENT** of River City Team Dues AND USA Waterski dues before a skier can participate in open water (river) practices or shows. If unable to pay in full, please contact Brad Gates, [brad@rivercitywaterski.com](mailto:brad@rivercitywaterski.com)
- All members/families will need to prepay the fundraiser amount. For the 2024 season we will be participating in a Spring 2024 Chicken Q, a Cookie fundraiser, RiverFest (June 30-July 4th), & Beer Cheese Wine Fest (April 2024).
- Anyone helping with the team in any way such as skiers, drivers, spotters, dock help, announcer, sound, etc., will need an active USA Water Ski membership prior to participation.
  - Any member 18 years and older that is a skier or a non-skier needs to have SAFE SPORT completed prior to the first day of practice, including dryland). For questions on this requirement contact Luke Raymer, [luke@rivercitywaterski.com](mailto:luke@rivercitywaterski.com)
- 20-hours of volunteer service for the team per family are **required**.
- **A minor child (under age 18) joining the team must have a parent/guardian join as well.** The parent/guardian does not need to pay USA Water Ski or WWSF fees unless he/she plans to ski or have active participation in skiing activities (dock, boat driving, spotting). River City does not charge its non-skiing members.

### Policies and Procedures:

- Read and sign Member's Handbook Acknowledgement form
- Attend practices regularly; inform show director(s) of absence prior to practice.
- No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking/vaping/e-cigs, or foul language allowed at the ski site before or during practices and shows.
- No members may participate in a show or practice while under the influence of drugs/alcohol.
- USA Water Ski membership must be current. Pay directly to [www.usawaterski.org](http://www.usawaterski.org)
- WI Water Ski Federation membership must be current if participating in the State Tournament. Pay directly to [www.waterski.org](http://www.waterski.org)

- **Must participate in yearly fundraisers**
